

Ukulele [Am] Jack Heffernan

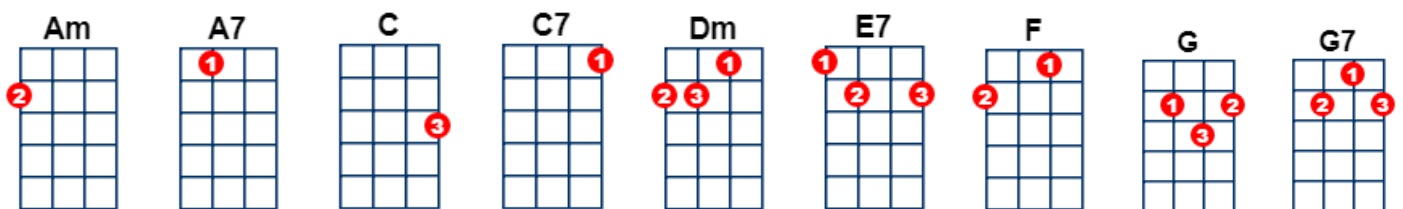
Parody of Delilah – Tom Jones
