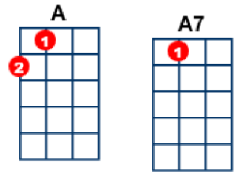

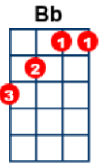

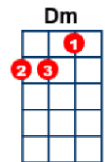
[F] Many's the **[Bb]** time **[F]** I've **[Gm]** been **[F]** mis-**[C]** tak-**[A]** en,

[Gm] So **[F]** far a-**[C]** way from **[F]** home

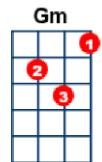


[F] I don't know **[Bb]** a soul **[F]** whose **[Gm]** not **[F]** been
